

Hurricane Safety



What Can You Do?

- Prepare, Prepare NOW is the time...
 BEFORE A Hurricane Threatens!!!
- Recognize and Know your vulnerabilities
- Prepare Emergency Supplies Kit (3-7 days)
 - Be Ready for Multi-day Power Outages
 - Bottled Water (1 gallon per person per day)
 - Non-perishable Foods canned meat, peanut butter, baked beans, etc.
 - Flashlight(s), Battery Operated/Crank Radio and extra Batteries
 - Piece Supplies Kit Together Over Time
